



The **Detroit Institute for Children** is proud to present **SLIDE**, our summer learning program for children with special needs, integrated into the Arc of Grosse Pointe/Harper Woods' Summer Program.

SLIDE (Summer Learning Individualized Developmental Experiences) will give children with special needs an opportunity to receive crucial therapies and prevent learning loss over the summer months.

ELIGIBILITY:

Any child aged 5-12 who is receiving special services through a school based Individualized Education Plan (IEP) in their Head Start, early intervention program or school is eligible to participate. Flexible schedules are possible; the Arc can accommodate vacations, ESY, and before & aftercare.

PROGRAM DATES:

SLIDE will be part of The Arc's existing program; students must register for the Arc program to also participate in SLIDE.

Program runs June 19 – August 18 in two sessions, with limited programming the week of July 10.

CURRICULUM:

Each day will be filled with activities designed to meet the needs of each child in the program with special themes presented every week. All activities are designed and lead by licensed therapists.
